JUDGING CATEGORY (Std.):

Playgroup, Nursery, KG, Std. 1 & 2, Std. 3 & 4, Std. 5 to 7, Std. 8 to 10, Std. 11 & 12 and Open (above 12 std & adults) category. Please note judging category may change on the basis of number of participants.

TYPE OF EVENTS:

YouTube based and Photo based. Type of event is specified in 'EVENTS IN DETAIL' section from Third page below each event name.

HOW TO SEND YOUR ENTRIES:

Through WhatsApp chat individual participation and Schools/Institute are requested to write us to get registration process through WhatsApp/Email. After receiving the entries and fees, within few working days entry number will be issued. After getting entry number from us, participants can proceed for recording the videos and making other contents.

REGISTRATION FEES:

INR 360 to 490 per entry: INR 360 till 31 December 2024, INR 390 from 1 January 2025 to 15 February 2025, INR 430 from 16 February 2025 to 15 March 2025 and after that INR 490 with late fees till 31 March 2025. Same fees is applied for students from other countries. Overseas students will get only e-certificate; to get the memento and hard copy of certificate courier charges will be applied.

Apart from Registration Fees, schools are allowed to charge maximum of **20% as an administrative fee**. This additional charge is allowed only if school is doing registration and other administrative work on behalf of parents.

PRIZE DISTRIBUTION:

Hard copy of Certificate and Memento (4x6inch wooden/glass material) will be delivered to respective school/Institute within 60 days from the result date. If memento or certificate gets damaged during transit than school/parents are request to send us back on provided address for replacement. We will replace/repair the memento without any cost but no compensation will be given for courier charges. If courier service of our courier agency is not available in your given address location then parents/school have to collect it from nearest courier office.

POINTS RELATED TO PHOTO BASED EVENT:

1. Participants of photo related events have to mention entry number, event name & Participants name on art work & then take photo. 2. Take photograph of the content only; not with participant.

POINTS RELATED TO YOUTUBE BASED EVENT:

1. Minimum video time limit is 2 mins. In youtube subject mention 'Carnival Rhythms Group & SCLRRC.'

2. Participants in performing events (YouTube) have to wear the entry number on their torso (chest) in plain view, so that it is clearly visible. Remember only entry number; no other details. Digitally mentioned entry number will be not be accepted.

- 3. If entry number is not there it will get auto rejected without any intimation.
- 4. Do not use any app to record video.
- 5. While uploading videos on YouTube please choose the sharing option as 'Unlisted'. Do not record in reel; only normal video.

6. Participants have to say entry number, name, std. and event name before starting their performance.

7. No assistance will be provided to upload the video on YouTube as process is simple and for any issues consult your near and dear ones.

RECORDING INSTRUCTIONS AND TECHNICAL POINTS:

1. Participants have to record the video indoors in a fixed frame mode.

2. Participants have to perform in either a seated or standing position except for dance, stylish Kid & Fancy dress without any movement whatsoever. Video Should be Horizontal.

3. Participants should perform on their own. Use of Teleprompter headphone or any other equipment to guide the participant is strictly prohibited.

4. Special effects, digital graphics, titles or animation in video shooting is strictly prohibited. Basic lighting may be used. Video should be recorded in a single take (there should not be any pause/start or any other editing).

VERY IMPORTANT POINTS:

1. You tube links & Photo (JPG format) should be submitted only through Google form link which will be provided after registration. We will not accept through any other medium.

2. Video/Photo through google drive, email or with other medium will not be accepted.

- 3. School/Institute should copy the YouTube link in the same Excel file in which we have sent entry no.
- 4. Video performed in other events will not be accepted.

5. Its compulsory to provide number of each participant. We communicate only on WhatsApp number.

6. Judges decision will be final; no query will be entertained related to judging.

7. Other than overall participants and total number of schools no other data will be shared (e.g. category/std. wise students, judges name etc.)

8. Rhythms Group keeps the right to publish the winners & participation photographs on social media, circular, brochure and other promotional platforms. Parents are requested not to share photographs if they do not wish to publish.

9. Winners list will be announced within 60 days from the last date of submission and prize dispatch process will start within 60 days from the winners announcement date.
